

The time is near for the FSA Test. All students will be taking the Florida FSA Writing Test on February  $30^{\text{th}}$ . This year, I am challenging all students to score 8 or higher on the FSA Writing exam. It is very important for all students to attend school everyday. In addition, parents can support your student on testing days by doing the following:

- Ensure your child has a good night sleep
- Eats a healthy breakfast
- Arrives on time each of the testing days
- Tries their best on the assessment
- Reviews and re-reads answers and writing

Remember, we have After–School Homework Help on Tuesdays and Thursdays for any student. This is paid for through our Title 1 funds and bus transportation is available. Parents and students, please take advantage of this resource by contacting your student's teacher to sign up. For students who need assistance in math, we have Math Lab every Wednesday morning from 7:45 to 8:30 AM.

Lastly, please continue to provide a learning environment at home by discussing with your student his or her progress in all classes, reviewing homework assignments, and providing a quiet place to read. We ask that our students read at least 30 minutes per evening. Our goal is for all students to make grade level progress, pass all of their classes, and be promoted to the next grade level.

More than 1 in 4 children will experience some form of bullying each year. 90% of teens ages 12-17 who have witnessed some form of online cruelty say they have *ignored* the behavior.

#### Bullying is different than conflict or disagreeing with someone. It's bullying if:

- The person is being hurt, harmed or humiliated with words or behavior.
- The behavior is repeated.
- It is being done intentionally.
- The person being hurt has a hard time defending himself or herself from the behavior.
- The student(s) who are doing it have more power.

## Homework Help

Homework Help is held every Tuesday & Thursday 3:00 pm – 4:20 pm Snack will be provided

Student's who need a bus stop assignment for the late bus, which leaves campus at 4:30 must communicate this to a teacher on their team. The teacher will present the student's name and the Homework Help team will request a bus stop for the student. It may take up to one week before a bus stop is assigned from District. The student must wait to receive confirmation that a bus stop has been assigned before staying after school.

Car riders, walkers, and bike-riders must inform a parent that they are staying after school for Homework Help. Carriders must be picked up no later than 4:30 pm.

This is not "one-on-one tutoring". The students will be expected to work independently, and come to the Homework Help sessions with overdue assignments or homework. If they need some help to get started then they can seek help from one of the teachers who is part of the Homework Help Team.
