Eighth Grade End of the Year Activities 2019 – 2020

Eighth grade activities are an exciting time for your child to make lasting memories with their friends and teachers before they continue their academic journey to high school. In order to make these activities as enjoyable as possible for every student, we would like to share some important information with you.

As part of our drive to meet our school's goal of preparing students to become successful in High School and in life, we have implemented strict eligibility requirements for our 8th Grade Activities **beginning Tuesday, January 21st**. Although these events are an important part of being an 8th grader at PRSMS, they are in reality a privilege that needs to be earned rather than a right that all students can enjoy. We are providing you with this information, so that you can assist your student in meeting these eligibility requirements. All students will be informed of these expectations at the beginning of second semester. Our desire is that every student in 8th grade will be able to earn the privilege of participating in the 8th Grade Activities for the end of the school year.

1) Students must meet <u>all</u> academic promotion requirements

- a. Pass the four core subjects (Language Arts, Math, Science, & Social Studies) for each of the 3 years in Middle School.
- b. Students with 6th & 7th grade course failures and/or current 8th grade course failures are not eligible for promotion and are therefore <u>not eligible</u> for the 8th Grade Activities. These students may participate in our Course Recovery program. A student must complete <u>all</u> Course Recovery courses and/or have a passing grade in <u>all</u> 8th grade core courses before they can become eligible to participate in the 8th Grade Activities and promotional ceremony. Students taking online classes for their core subject areas who have <u>not</u> completed the required three years, must be on track for completion by the end of the school year.

2) Students must meet behavior expectations

- a. Students who receive O.S.S. *beginning January 21st* are <u>not eligible</u> for <u>any</u> 8th grade activities.
- b. Students who receive I.S.S. beginning January 21st are not eligible for the following 8th Grade Activities:
 - i. 1^{st} Referral w/ISS = No 8th Grade Field Trip
 - ii. 2nd Referral w/ISS = No 8th Grade Field Trip and No 8th Grade Dance
 - iii. 3rd Referral w/ISS = No 8th Grade Field Trip, No 8th Grade Dance, and

No 8th Grade Field Day

Please Note:

Students who meet the eligibility requirements for the 8th Grade Activities will be entitled to participate in any and all events of their choice. Students who are initially eligible will need to maintain their grades and their disciplinary success in order to remain eligible. <u>Students who</u> <u>become ineligible due to academic difficulties or disciplinary issues will forfeit their participation and fees paid in whatever 8th Grade</u> <u>Activities remain on the calendar. Please note that No Refunds can be given.</u> Students, who currently do not meet the academic eligibility requirements, may become eligible for promotion by raising their 8th grade class grades to passing or by completing any 6th & 7th grade Course Recovery courses for courses failed in the 6th & 7th grades. If the student recovers all previously failed 6th & 7th grade courses and improves all of their 8th grade core academic class grades to passing, then the student would meet the eligibility requirements for the 8th Grade Activities. Any student with outstanding balances with PRSMS, must be paid in full prior to 8th grade activities payment. We will not be taking 8th grade activities payments until these balances have been paid. Please contact our school bookkeeper to inquire on any outstanding balances.

****No REFUNDS** will be given for any 8th grade activity. Prices are set. Tickets purchased for the field trip are only valid on May 2nd, 2020. Once field trip tickets are ordered on March 27th, students must govern themselves in a way that will allow them to remain eligible. If your child receives any **disciplinary actions** *beginning January* 21st resulting in their not participating in the 8th grade activities, there will be <u>no</u> refunds given.

- 2nd Referral w/ISS = Loss of 8th Grade Field Trip and 8th Grade Dance
- 3rd Referral w/ISS = Loss of 8th Grade Field Trip, 8th Grade Dance, and 8th Grade Field Day
